

MINUTES
Lefors City Council Meeting
June 10, 2024 - Regular Session
7:00 p.m.

The meeting was called to order at 7:01 p.m. by Mayor Michael Ray. Present were Council members Ashley Miller, James Gee, Jerry Stegall, Savannah Kingcade, and Aaron Hunt.

Mayor Ray led the Pledge of Allegiance. Councilman Gee said the Invocation.

Public works director, Nick York, submitted a report: 1) repaired numerous water leaks, 2) repaired water main off of skyline that was hit, 3) replaced pump at ground storage tank, 4) removed arm on trash truck, waiting for new one to be built and installed, 5) new electric flow meters installed at well#7 and well #8, 6) Installed sump pump at well #7, 7) had hydraulic cylinder on old trash truck repaired, 8) lightning struck well #6. (pump is down.)

City Judge Kurt Curfman submitted a written report: For the month of May 2024, we had receipts of \$360.00. There were several new complaints or citations filed with the Court from the Marshal. These were for state or City ordinances violations. The Marshal will be out of the office for a while, but we are still taking complaints and payment during this time. At this current time, we have an outstanding balance of fines and court costs due to the City of Lefors of \$6,295.00 plus warrants of \$3,720.00. All local, state, and federal reports are current at this time.

City Marshal, Hayden Gray, submitted a written report: Calls for service: On duty: 2, Call-out: 1, Traffic Stops: 5 Traffic Citations (to include parking violations) issued: 2, Warnings issued: 3, City Ordinance Warnings (to include verbal warnings) issued: 3

Councilwoman Miller made a motion to approve the consent agenda items including minutes of the May 13, 2024, regular meeting, bills, and department reports. Councilman Hunt seconded. Vote unanimous. Motion passed.

Councilman Hunt made a motion to replace the valve, riser, and meter and repair the City side of the line at 614 E. First when the customer has completed work on the customer side and service is ready to be restored. Councilwoman Kingcade seconded. Vote unanimous. Motion passed.

Councilwoman Kingcade made a motion to allow Public Works Director, Nick York, to attend the Public Drinking Water Conference in Austin , August 6-7, 2024, for CE hours and training. Councilwoman Miller seconded. Vote unanimous. Motion passed.

Councilwoman Miller made a motion to adjourn. Councilman Hunt seconded. Vote unanimous. Motion passed.
