

MINUTES
Lefors City Council Meeting
October 9, 2023- Regular Session

The meeting was called to order at 7:00 p.m. by Mayor Michael Ray. Present were Council members Ashley Miller, Jerry Stegall, Savannah Kingcade, James Gee, and Aaron Hunt.

Mayor Ray led the Pledge of Allegiance. Councilman Gee said the Invocation.
No citizens were present for comments.

Public Works Director, Nick York, submitted a written report: 1) Repaired multiple leaks on the main on Magnolia, 2) Repaired water leak on 6" main on 2nd street, 3) Replaced riser and meter for the Baptist Church, 4) Replaces a sewer tap off of East Street between 4th and 5th, 5) Mowed and cleaned town for school reunion, 6.) Repaired multiple alleys throughout town, 7.) Replaced water riser for Daniel Parman.

Councilwoman Miller made a motion to approve the items on the consent agenda including minutes from the September 11, 2023, regular meeting, bills, and department reports. Councilman Hunt seconded. Vote unanimous. Motion passed.

Councilwoman Miller made a motion to open a checking account at First Bank & Trust and designate Michael Ray, Mayor, Savannah Kingcade, Mayor Pro-Tem, and Lindy Forsyth, City Secretary, as signatories. Councilman Hunt seconded. Vote unanimous. Motion passed.

Councilman Hunt made a motion change Council/employee credit on billing from sewer to base water. Councilwoman Kingcade seconded. Vote unanimous. Motion passed.

The Council went into Executive Session at 7:17 to discuss personnel. (*Texas Government Code §551.074 Personnel Matters*)

The Council returned to regular session at 7:40.
