

MINUTES
Lefors City Council
October 15, 2025-Regular Meeting

Mayor Michael Ray called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. Present were Council members Jerry Stegall, Savannah Kingcade, Aaron Hunt, and James Gee. Council member Ashley Miller was absent.

Mayor Ray led the Pledge of Allegiance.

Councilman Gee said the Invocation.

Citizens present: Denny Boyd

Public comments-None.

Public Works Director, Chad Young reported to Council that they had to lay a new water line for Merray Stroud. When the contractors did the grant work on First St., the line that went to his house was cut out and not replaced. He is back in service now. Young also reported that the manhole at Main and Thut has been raised about the level of the road so when the TxDot does the sealcoating on the Spur this week it will not be covered up again, but level with the road.:

City Judge, Kurt Curfman, submitted a written report: For the month of September 2025, we had receipts of \$0.00. There was one new complaint filed with the Court. This was for State or City Ordinance violations. At this current time, we have an outstanding balance of fines and court costs due to the City of Lefors of \$200.00, plus warrants of \$9,522.00. We are current with all local, state, and federal reports.

Councilman Hunt made a motion to approve the consent agenda including the minutes from the September 8, 2025, regular meeting, bills, and department reports. Councilwoman Kingcade seconded. Vote unanimous. Motion passed.

A discussion was held regarding possibly providing sanitation service for customers that are not residents of Lefors. More information needs to be gathered. Tabled until next meeting.

Council went into Executive session at 7:08 p.m. to discuss personnel under Texas Government Code §551.074 (Personnel Matters).

Council returned to Regular session at 7:30 p.m.

Councilman Hunt brought forth his motion made in executive session contract with Clay Aufleger for the amount \$100.00 per month for use of his licensing for public utilities. Councilman Gee seconded. Vote unanimous. Motion passed.

Councilman Hunt brought forth his motion made in executive session to hire Dalton Cross as a full time public works employee at \$16.00 per hour. Councilman Stegall seconded. Vote unanimous. Motion passed.

Councilman Hunt made a motion to adjourn. Councilman Stegall seconded. Vote unanimous. Motion passed.
